

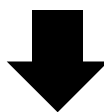

Discuss why you believe that these traits are so important and how you feel that they are developed in an individual.”*. NO GPA required. Award is \$1,000. **Deadline: May 31, 2019**

**Eligibility:** **9-12 grade; legal resident** of the state; plan on attending an accredited post-secondary institution of higher education no later than the fall of 2025. Submit an online short written response (250 words or less) for the scholarship topic: *“May is the fifth month of the year. Write a letter to the number five explaining why five is important. Be serious or be funny. Either way, here’s a high five to you for being original.”* Award is \$1,500. While scholarship opportunities for undocumented students seem scarce, there are opportunities nonetheless. Not all scholarships will explicitly call for "undocumented" students - they may require students to have a specific status such as DACA, AB 540, etc. Some scholarships may not even ask about immigration status or citizenship, so you may qualify for those scholarships if you are currently undocumented. Make sure to check your state's immigration laws and policies when applying for scholarships and other forms of financial aid.
